Scholarship Foundation at Nova Southeastern University's Fischler School of Education. Since its inception in 2005 over 200,000 students in the United States have participated in the program.

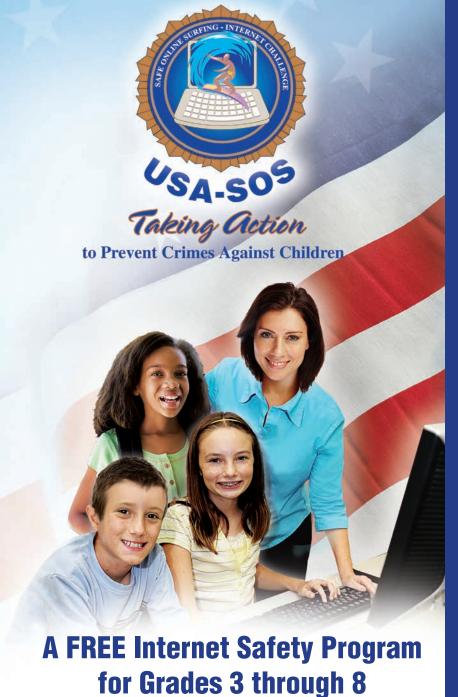

Program Overview

The USA-SOS (Safe Online Surfing)

Internet Challenge is a FREE, online, educational program that promotes cyber citizenship and teaches students how to recognize and react to online dangers. The program delivers critical internet safety information in a fun, competitive format to students in the 3rd through 8th grades.



Registration

A teacher or administrator registers his/her school at www.usa-sos.org.
Students then create a unique username and password and become part of their school's team.

Pre-Quiz

Students begin by taking an online, multiple-choice, self-scoring Pre-Quiz to measure their knowledge of internet safety and cyber citizenship.

Scavenger Hunt

Students embark on an online Scavenger Hunt and visit pre-screened websites to pick up important internet safety and cyber citizenship information.

Post-Quiz

Students take the USA-SOS Post-Quiz to demonstrate what they learned. All quiz questions are based on the information found during the Scavenger Hunt.

Topics by Grade

There is a separate USA-SOS Internet Challenge for each grade, 3rd through 8th. The program is designed to build upon itself from one year to the next by introducing new concepts in each grade while reinforcing the information previously learned. This format also ensures that students starting the program in later grades are exposed to all topics. During the program, students are introduced to important internet terms and some of the laws governing online activity in addition to the
